#### A. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The authorised person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
- 2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the State Pollution Control Board.
- 3. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorisation.
- 4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
- 5. The person authorised shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorisation is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time.
- 6. The person authorised shall comply with the provisions outlined in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on Implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty.
- 7. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.
- 8. The imported hazardous and other wastes shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its clean-up operation.
- 9. The record of consumption and fate of the imported hazardous and other wastes shall be maintained.
- 10. The hazardous and other waste which gets generated during recycling or reuse or recovery or pre-processing or utilisation of imported hazardous or other wastes shall be treated and disposed of as per specific conditions of authorisation.
- 11. The importer or exporter shall bear the cost of import or export and mitigation of damages if any.
- 12. An application for the renewal of an authorisation shall be made as laid down under these Rules.
- 13. Any other conditions for compliance as per the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
- 14. Annual return shall be filed by June 30th for the period ensuring 31st March of the year.

#### **B. SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. This authorization under Hazardous Wastes (Management Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 is granted for Category 5.1 @ 12 KL/Annum and Category 35.1 @ 4365 T/Annum, only.
- 2. The transporter shall use Vehicle No. PB10JQ5839 and Registration no. PB-1020100055276 only for transportation of hazardous waste from the industry i.e. M/s Vardhman Special Steels Ltd. to TSDF at Village Nimbua, Derabassi after following proper manifest system (as per HWM Rules, 2016) and shall ensure that this vehicle is not used for any other purpose.
- 3. The industry shall provide GPS tracker on the vehicle and share the details of the same with the Board for real time tracking.
- 4. The industry shall dispose off its hazardous waste category no. 5.1 to the authorized unit / recycler / reprocessor having valid Registration Certificate-cum-Pass Book from Punjab Pollution Control Board / respective State Pollution Control Board and valid authorization of the State Board under the said Rules and consents to operate under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and authorization under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 5. The industry shall dispose off its hazardous waste generated as per provisions of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 6. The industry shall submit record of manifests of lifting of hazardous waste in form 10, as per the provisions of Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 7. The industry shall not generate/ store/ collect/ dispose any other category of hazardous waste from its premise, except the category of hazardous waste(s) for which it has been granted this authorization under the HWM Rules, 2016.
- 8. The industry shall store its hazardous wastes generated from different manufacturing activities/ otherwise, within its premises in an environmentally sound manner as per provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 9. The industry will apply for fresh authorization in case category-wise quantity of hazardous waste for which it has been authorized, exceeds.
- 10. The industry shall ensure regular lifting of hazardous waste and also ensure that the quantity of hazardous waste generated per year shall not be stored beyond 90 days (extendable up to 180 days) in its premises at any time.
- 11. The industry shall handle the hazardous waste(s) strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board/ Ministry of Environment & Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi.
- 12. In case the industry fails to comply with the above conditions of authorization as well as provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and/or any other environmental law applicable to the industry and Rules, Circulars & Directions issued by the Board from time to time, the Board shall constrain to take action against the industry under the provisions of the Pollution Control Laws.
